

M.I. ENROLMENT GUIDELINES

① TEACH

Teach or explain MI Primer Catechism available from MI Enrolment Station. An Enrolment station is any place designated by the MI, such as a Pilgrimage post, a Priory, a Mass Center or a Catechism Center.

②

TEST & SIGN FORM

- ① Verify understanding of MI Primer Catechism and test on 5 things: Applicant can say the Rosary, understands sufficiently to Confess & Communicate, knows the Commandments, the duties of the MI, has efficacious desire to consecrate self to Our Lady for Her service.
- ② Check the relevant boxes on the MI Enrolment form obtainable from MI Enrolment Station. Applicant may not check the boxes himself.
- ③ After checking the boxes, sign the Enrolment form on the back side under the rubric "*Presenting Catechist/Priest _____*", as the presenting Catechist signifying that the applicant has been reviewed regarding the major points of the MI Primer Catechism for consecrated service.
- ④ The applicant will sign the Enrolment form on the front side, in the rubric "*I _____ understand etc...*" signifying his understanding of MI Primer Catechism and his desire for consecrated service. The applicant may sign the enrolment form at any time.

③

PRESENT TO PRIEST & REGISTER

Present the enrolment form to your Priest, explaining and verifying the applicant's aptitude. The presenting Priest then signs the Enrolment form. Return Enrolment form to MI Enrolment station, or instruct applicant to do so. Receive registry No. – the official registry number for each MI – or the applicant receives it himself, from personnel at MI Enrolment Station.

④ CEREMONY OF ENROLMENT

Applicant presents registry no. at Consecration & Enrolment ceremony, makes consecration and receives Miraculous medal.
